Instructions





Two teams play against each other. 1-3 persons form a team. Every team plays with 6 balls. Team A plays with white balls and team B plays with yellow balls.



Team A plays the first white ball



Team B plays the first yellow ball



2nd round

If both teams play the same number of balls into the target fields, the team with the higher score wins the round.

3 balls on 3 is better than 3 balls on 2 regardless of the number of balls on the joker field.

Joker and number field points are equal.



Team B scores 9 points



1st round

Alternately, both teams play all 12 balls into the target field until all balls are played. It is allowed to touch the bar marks and other balls. The team with the most balls in the same target field wins the appropriate score.

1. number of balls and 2. score

Four balls on a "1" is better than three balls on a "2".

A ball on the joker field can be counted as any number field.



Only the winner team can record the score on the scoreboard after a played round. **Team A** scores **four points**.

The team, which played the last ball, starts in the following round.

If a round ends in a tie for both teams with the same number of points, no points are usually scored. If a team plays with the opponent's ball, or a ball leaves the game field, the round is stopped and 6 points can be credited to the opponent.



1st set win

The team that first reaches 18 points or more wins the first set. The winner of the first set opens the second round.

A cross golf game is played in two sets.
